- 11. Attend, host and/or sponsor an event.
- 12. Serve on a committee and/or volunteer for an event (see website).
- 13. Refer a friend/business associate to your Chamber.
- 14. Make a Why Us? testimonial for your Chamber.
- 15. Refer a fellow member to a potential customer (via Chamber website).

Suggested Member Timeline

So, where should you begin as a new member or a newly engaged member?

<u>First Month</u>

1. **Check your member listing on the Chamber website** to ensure that it is accurate and up-to-date. The Chamber will send you an e-mail when your listing has been added to the website. *Remember to check this at least annually*

2. Make sure the Chamber has your brochures and/or business cards so the staff can provide referrals for you and also include your information in relocation packets.

3. **Complete the Green Business Recognition and Member Spotlight forms.** The Chamber staff and fellow members will learn more about you, and your listing will include the special Green Business distinction.

4. **Register for a Breakfast Briefing.** The Chamber offers a morning networking breakfast for Chamber members and prospective members. Hear the latest news about activities, events, benefits and other members. All attendees may give a 28-second "elevator speech" about their business/organization.

5. **Embed the Chamber E-Plaque on your website.** Give your website a little more notoriety and prestige. It also shows that you are proud to be a member of the Central PA Chamber!

At Breakfast Briefings, every attendee gives a 28-second 'elevator speech', which serves as great practice in a comfortable atmosphere and often leads to new business!



Within the First 3 Months

6. Set up an appointment to visit the Chamber. We'll provide a 1-on-1 tour!

7. Schedule a 1-on-1 meeting with a member of the Chamber staff: Tea Jay, Ryan and Jessica. Each staff member can assist you with membership questions, but each also specialize in certain areas.

8. Attend the "What is the Central PA Chamber?" Seminar. This in-person class held each quarter provides detailed information about member benefits.

9. Send information to share in *It's Your Business* and/or advertise. IYB is published monthly in digital form, providing members with regular opportunities to promote their business/organization. This could include a new product or service, hire, certification or honor, etc. Flyer inserts for IYBQ (quarterly print publication) must be 8.5" x 11" or smaller. Advertising rates for IYB and IYBQ are affordable for any size budget! Call Ryan Workman at 570-742-7341 for ad rates and submission dates!

10. **Offer a Member-to-Member Discount.** Offering exclusive discounts to fellow members gives you additional exposure for your business and helps build connections between members. You can offer discounts for any length of time and change as needed.

Within the First Year

11. **Attend, host and/or sponsor an event.** We offer a variety of networking events and sponsorship opportunities (see *Member Benefits & Opportunities Guide* for details). Some events include: the Annual Meeting & Awards Ceremony, Breakfast Briefing, Business & Education Association Golf Tournament, Legislative Events, Inside Jobs Tours, Ribbon Cuttings and more!

12. **Serve on a committee and/or volunteer for an event.** Current committees, organized by staff members, are: Budget & Finance; Business & Education; Membership & Engagement; and Public Relations.

13. Refer a friend/business associate to your Chamber.

14. **Record a "Why Us?" testimonial for your Chamber.** See current videos on our website! This is a great way to get some free PR!

15. **Refer a fellow member to a potential customer.** The referral system is quick and easy to use in the online member directory.
